The Corporation of the Township of North Kawartha

By-law 2022-0108

Being a by-law of the Corporation of the Township of North Kawartha Kawartha to adopt the Shoreline Road Allowance Closure Policy and Application dated January 1, 2023 and repeal by-law 2021-0060 and all other by-laws contrary to this by-law

Whereas under Section 9 of the Municipal Act, 2001, S.O. 2001, c.25, provides that a Municipality has the capacity, rights, powers and privileges of a natural person for the purpose of exercising its authority under this or any other Act;

And Whereas Section 270(1.1) of the Municipal Act, 2001, S.O., 2001, c.25 provides a Municipality shall adopt and maintain policies with respect to the following matters: Its sale and other disposition of land;

And Whereas Section 391(1) of the Municipal Act, 2001, S.O., 2001, c.25 provides that the Council of a Municipality may pass by-laws to impose fees or charges on persons for services or activities provided or done by or on behalf of it;

And Whereas Section 34(1) of the Municipal Act, 2001, S.O., 2001, c.25 provides that a by-law permanently closing a highway does not take effect until a certified copy of the by-law is registered in the proper land registry office;


And Whereas Section 34(2) of the Municipal Act, 2001, S.O., 2001, c.25 provides that a by-law permanently closing a highway shall not be passed without the consent of the Government of Canada if the highway, abuts on land, including land covered by water, owned by the Crown in right of Canada; or leads to or abuts on a bridge, wharf, dock, guay or other work owned by the Crown in right of Canada;

Whereas the Corporation of the Township of North Kawartha deems it expedient to amend the Shoreline Road Allowance Closure Policy as applicable to provide an updated fee schedule;

Now Therefore the Council of the Corporation of the Township of North Kawartha hereby enacts:

- 1. That the Shoreline Road Allowance Closure Policy attached as Schedule "A" is adopted;
- 2. That this by-law will come into force and effect upon the 1st day of January, 2023:
- 3. That the provisions of by-laws 2021-0060 and all other by-laws contrary to this by-law be repealed.
