### Glass

Coloured and clear bottles and jars

### Plastic

Food and drink containers, tubs and lids

### Metal

- Pop cans, pie plates and tin foil
- Food and drink cans and tins
- Empty metal paint cans, lids removed
- Empty aerosol cans

### Cartons and Cups

- Milk cartons and juice boxes
- Paper coffee cups

#### Do Not Include

- Ceramic or other dishes. Any broken glass.
- Motor oil containers, straws, toys.
- Scrap metal, utensils, pots and pans.
- Styrofoam of any kind.

## Paper

Newspaper, writing/office paper, magazines, telephone books, envelopes, junk mail and flyers, paper bags

### Boxes

Flattened small boxes can be placed loose in bin. Large boxes can be bundled 30" x 30" x 8" and put beside bin.

### Other Fibres

Paper tubes from toilet paper and paper towel

# Plastic Bags

Film plastics, grocery, milk, bread bags – place all in one and tie

#### Do Not Include

- Chip bags, plastic stretch wrap, candy and cheese wrappers.
- Solid Foil lined meal delivery boxes place foil in garbage, then recycle box
- Liners from cracker/cereal boxes
