The Corporation of the Township of North Kawartha By-law 2018-085

Being a by-law of the Corporation of the Township of North Kawartha to amend By-Law 2012-046 which regulates the setting of open air fires, by including the ban of flying lanterns.

Whereas; the Fire Protection and Prevention Act, 1997, S.O. 1997, c.4, s.7.1 (1) (a) provides that a Council of a Municipality may pass By-laws regulating fire prevention, including the prevention of the spreading of fires;

And Whereas it is desirable to amend By-law # 46/12 being a by-law to regulate conditions under which fires may be set in the open air or in contained sites and precautions to be observed by persons setting fire;

Now Therefore the Council of The Corporation of the Township of North Kawartha enacts as follows:

- Amend section 1. Definitions by adding:
 Flying lantern is a small hot air balloon made of paper, with an opening at the bottom where a small fire is suspended. Also known as sky lantern;
- 2. Amend section 2. Requirements, by adding: No person shall ignite or use a flying lantern.

That this by-law comes into force and effect on the 21st day of August, 2018.

Read a first, second and third time and passed in open Council on the 21st day of August, 2018.
