Subject: 2025 Council Expenses

Recommendation:

Direction to staff, stating specific Council members and dollar amount to be reallocated.

Background:

The Township's annual budgets include an amount for Council expenses, which is divided amongst the five Council members. This amount is utilized for Council expenditures; typically for mileage for Township business, as well as for conference registration and associated costs.

The 2024 Council Expense account in the amount of \$12,500 was allocated as follows: Mayor \$2,500, Deputy Mayor \$2,000, Councillor At Large \$2,000, Ward One Councillor \$2,000, Ward Two Councillor \$2,000, and Council Initiatives for municipal property tour and miscellaneous workshops \$2,000.

The December 11, 2024 budget meeting minutes include this statement, regarding the 2025 Council Expense account: "Council Members expenses were discussed leaving the budgeted amounts the same as in 2024 but with the option to seek Council approval to transfer expenses between members accounts if needed."

Analysis:

Upon review of Council members' expense accounts, it has come to staff's attention that a reallocation of funds will be required in order for Mayor Amyotte to fulfill her duties as Head of Council for the remainder of the year.

A motion of council will be required to reallocate funds from another council member to add to the Mayor's allotment.
